Balance of funds as of March 1, 2024:

For the "Life after the war" project -	€4,594

The main projects of the fund are:
"Iron Hawk" - a mobile station for a special air reconnaissance unit and
"Life after the war" - social rehabilitation of veterans who lost their sight while defending Ukraine

“IRON HAWK”



In March, we continued to equip Iron Hawk - 2 for one of the UAV strike units of the Airborne Assault Forces of the Armed Forces of Ukraine and incurred the following costs:

- night vision device PVS-14 GEN3 White Phosphor AG MG

The project costs amounted to **€3,993**

To complete the mobile station, we need to purchase a system to reduce the impact of drones.

Given the difficult situation at the front, our Iron Hawk has been delivered to a combat unit. The ordered equipment will be promptly completed

On March 17-31, 2024, the Western Rehabilitation and Sports Center hosted our first rehabilitation and recovery camp this year for veterans who lost their eyesight while defending Ukraine.

6 veterans, together with their family members, underwent rehabilitation aimed at primary social adaptation to life after vision loss. At the same time, 8 veterans who had already completed a basic course of social adaptation improved the practical application of their previously acquired knowledge, skills and abilities.

The Fund's share amounted to **€4,940**
In March, we paid. **€3,952**

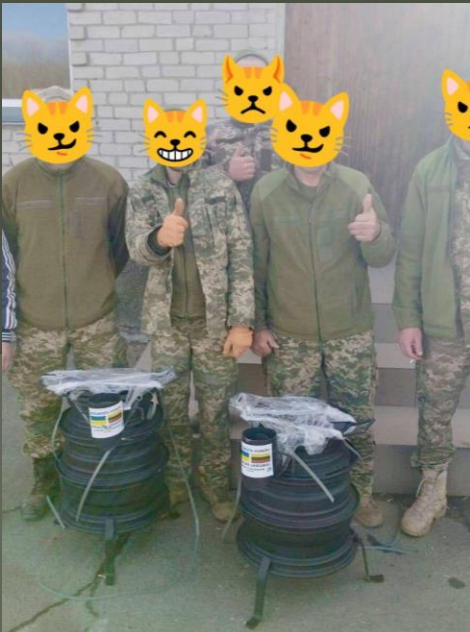
