In May, a Ukrainian from England, **Andriy Barchyshyn**, donated a Jeep Grand Cherokee **to the "Angry Birds" reconnaissance and strike UAV unit**. We are sincerely grateful for this noble deed of the Ukrainian patriot! On the basis of this vehicle, we plan to equip Iron Hawk-3 for this unit.

So far, we have paid for the repair and maintenance of the car.

The amount of expenses amounted to: **€1,800**

The configuration of Iron Hawk 3 will be agreed with the unit in the near future



## “Life after the war ”



From May 16 to 30, a regular rehabilitation camp for war veterans who lost their eyesight while defending Ukraine was held in Vinnytsia. This is the sixth such event within the framework of our Life After War project.

Another 8 veterans and 2 members of their families began their journey to acquire new, necessary skills for their future independent life after losing their sight.

The Fund's share amounted to - **€1,654.68**

## TARGETED DONATIONS



Along with our main projects, we are always happy to respond to requests from benefactors to buy something that is extremely necessary for a specific unit of the Armed Forces of Ukraine. All those who are defending Ukraine in this difficult time with arms in their hands are our number one priority.

In May, we acquired or joined the company:

- for one of the units of the Kyiv TRO holding the front in Chasovyi Yar, was purchased **DJI Mavic 3 Enterprise Thermo** worth **€5,150** and a set of additional batteries for it (3 batteries + charging hub) worth **€580**
- **We contributed to the repair of a Mitsubishi Pajero Sport for the 101st Air Assault Platoon of the OBRO Brigade in the amount of €500**
