# Life after the war



From March 20 to April 2, a regular social adaptation camp was held for veterans who lost their sight while defending Ukraine.

In the Lviv region, at the Western Rehabilitation and Sports Center of the National Committee for Sports of People with Disabilities of Ukraine, 12 veterans with vision loss began their journey back to an active, full life.

The participants gained the skills to:

- ✓ Manage everyday life independently
- ✓ Orientation in space
- ✓ Use modern digital technologies
- ✓ Strengthen physical and psychological condition

The Foundation's share in the joint project amounted to **EURO 3,820**

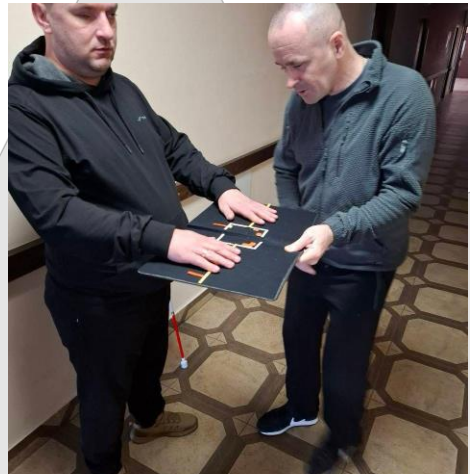
